From Mooi River: Follow Giant's Castle signs and continue on Giant's Castle Road for 25 km, turn Right onto a dirt road when you see a sign for "Moor Park 12 km," continue 9 km and Dalton's gate will be on your Left.

From Estcourt: Follow signs towards Wembezi, turn Left onto a dirt road towards Moor Park 6 km from Estcourt, keep Left over a cattle grid past Greystone Church, pass Wagendrift Dam on your Left, cross over a bridge at the Bushman's River, continue about 1.5 km to Dalton's gate on your Right.
